

Bathroom Spring Cleaning Routine

1

GATHER YOUR MATERIALS

- Box/bag for clutter that belongs elsewhere
- Trash bag.
- Long-handled duster and/or step stool.
- Cleaning cloths.
- Baking soda.
- White vinegar.
- Spray bottle of all-purpose cleaner.
- Soap scum remover.
- Bucket of hot, soapy water.
- Glass cleaner.
- Rubber gloves.
- Broom and dust pan.
- Mop.

CLEAR THE ROOM

- Laundry into the hamper.
- Rugs to the washing machine.
- Clutter into the box.
- Trash into the bag.
- Empty cupboards & drawers one at a time, tossing trash and putting clutter in box.
- Wipe cupboards & drawers as you work.

GET RID OF GRIME

- Clean the fans and vents.
- Dust the room top to bottom.
- Use dry cloth to pre-clean the vanity, tub surround, tub/shower floor, toilet tank and pedestal.

SPRAY THE SURFACES

- Remove the shower curtain and wash it.
- Spray soap scum remover on the shower and tub.
- Spray the vanity and sinks with disinfectant.
- Spray the toilet tank, seat and pedestal with disinfectant.
- Let the disinfectant sit while you proceed.

CLEAN THE WOOD FIXTURES

- Crown molding.
- Door jambs.
- Window sills and tracks.
- Doors (both sides).
- Cupboard and drawer fronts.
- Baseboards.

RINSE, FLUSH AND SCRUB

- Rinse the shower and tub.
- Rinse the vanity.
- Rinse the toilet tank, seat and pedestal.
- Flush the toilet.
- Scrub the toilet bowl and flush again.

CLEAN THE FLOOR

- Put the clutter box and trash out of the room.
- Sweep the floor.
- Mop the floor.

FINISH UP

- Polish the mirrors and faucets.
- Hang fresh towels.
- Return clean rugs to floor.
- Clean trash can and return it.
- Return clean shower curtain.
- Take trash bag to garbage can.
- Return items in clutter box to where they belong.



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
